School Meals

The cost of school meals remains at £2.60 per day, or £13.00 per week. Please send money in a labelled envelope.

Snack Money



Pupils in P1 to P4 should send £3 snack money in a labelled envelope, separate from dinner money into school each Monday morning. P1 pupils should send £1.80 on 29/08/18 and P2-P4 should send £1.20 on 30/08/18.

School Uniform

Could I remind parents to please ensure your child wears full school uniform to school each day.

Boys – polo shirt, school sweatshirt, grey trousers, grey socks, black shoes or black trainers (no jogging bottoms or multicoloured trainers).

Girls – polo shirt, school sweatshirt, grey skirt/pinafore/trousers, black tights/white socks, black shoes or black trainers (no jogging bottoms or multicoloured trainers.)

On PE days, P1-P4 children should bring the appropriate sportswear in their PE bags which can be left in school if so desired.

Key Stage 2 PE Uniform

From the 5th September 2018 pupils from P5 – P7 should come to school on their PE day (Wednesday) wearing plain black/navy sports bottoms/leggings and trainers. These will be worn with their school Polo Shirt and Jumper.

Free school meals

If money coming into your house is £16,190 per year, or less, you could be entitled to free school meals/free uniform for your child. If you think this could apply to you, please ask in school for the necessary form.
